



IYRP Symposium at 2023 SRM conference, Boise, Idaho

At the 76th Annual Conference of the Society for Range Management (SRM), its International Affairs Committee (IAC) and the IYRP ISG (International Support Group for the International Year of Rangelands & Pastoralists) convened an online symposium on "**Global issues influencing success for the IYRP, 2026 and beyond**" on 7 February 2023, the week before the hybrid SRM conference in Boise, Idaho (12–16 Feb) where the IYRP featured in several sessions.
